Pupil Dress Code

A reminder for all parents and students.

- Students should wear **black school trousers, which are not ripped for fashion purposes, or a black skirt**. For health reasons we advise students not to wear two pairs of trousers.
- Students should wear **black school shoes or trainers**; students must not wear 'sliders' or beach shoes – they are not suitable for a school environment and pose a real health risk.
- In order to focus on learning and be comfortable students will be asked to take their **coats and all outer wear will be handed in and stored in reception** as soon as students arrive on site at the start of the day.
- Tops should be of a sensible style e.g. **white shirts or polo shirts** and should ensure they are appropriate for school and cover the midriff and shoulders.
- Students should wear a **Francis Barber black sweatshirt or plain black jumper or sweatshirt**. Hoodies/ hoods are not permitted.
- Hats, caps, scarves and sunglasses continue to not be acceptable at any time on site and should be handed into reception on arrival with any bags/pouches, mobile phones or electronic devices.
